

North Carolina State Exam for Veterinarians and Veterinary Technicians

VTNE Candidates:

- The North Carolina Veterinary Medical Board will provide a list of incoming veterinary technicians who need to sit for the state exam to the AAVSB every Tuesday.
- A list of eligible candidates will be sent to TesTrac at the middle and end of the VTNE application window.
- You will receive an email from @testrac.com with your Logon ID and Password as well as the link to your exam login page.
- Once you have received your email from TesTrac, you have 60 days to login and take the exam. If your assignment expires, please email spa@aavsb.org requesting your exam to be reset.
- After you have logged in, scroll to the bottom of the page and click "I accept these terms and conditions," after reading through them.
- Click on the exam "Assigned to me".
- You will then pay the exam fee of \$55 by credit card. All major credit cards are accepted.
- This is an open book exam and you can access the jurisdiction's statutes, laws and rules on the jurisdiction's website. http://www.ncvmb.org/applicants.php?section=exams_tech#content
- There are 50 questions; 35 true/false and 15 multiple choice. You have 30 minutes to complete the exam. The pass rate is 75%.
- You will be provided a pass or fail at the end of the exam.
- TesTrac will provide your score to the AAVSB every Monday, which will then be sent to the North Carolina Veterinary Medical Board.
- Contact the North Carolina Veterinary Medical Board for next steps in the licensure process.
- If you need to retake the state exam, you will need to pay the \$55 exam fee again. The AAVSB will send you retake information and you will receive another email from TesTrac with new logon information.
